CALL TO PARTICIPANTS

Bowling Green/Warren County Community Education, U. S. Bank, and the Spell-A-Bratton 2012 partners invite upper elementary, middle and high school youth to create an 18" X 12" poster for the annual Spell-a-Bratton Art Show. This year's theme is "GOOD NEIGHBORS." Entries will be judged by independent judges. Prize details and rules are outlined below. A list of teaching activities, tips for artwork, and a rubric is also included.

Primary students (K-2) are invited to participate in a "Good Neighbor" themed art contest. They will also be judged by the independent panel of judges. Prize details and rules are outlined below.

Rules & Regulations

All Poster entries:

- ◆ Only original artwork is permitted. Clipart, photocopies, or tracings incorporated in the poster will not be accepted. Fragile media, i.e. pastel, charcoal, graphite, must be sealed with fixative. No glitter is allowed.
 - ◆ **Grades 3 – 12:** All posters must be vertical format, 18" X 12", unmatted and 2 dimensional.
 - ◆ Posters will be judged in these age categories: Grades 3 – 5, Grades 6 – 8, Grades 9 – 12.
 - ◆ **Grades K – 2:** All art entries must be horizontal format, 9" X 12", and 2 dimensional.
 - ◆ Art contest entries will be judged as one category, grades K – 2.
 - ◆ Creased or folded posters will not be accepted.
 - ◆ All posters must be received by Friday, **January 13**. Posters should be brought to the Community Education office, 1227 Westen Avenue, across from CDS #10.
 - ◆ Fill out the label and affix it to the back of the poster in the lower left corner.
 - ◆ Each division will be considered for the following:
 - The top poster entry in each age/grade division will receive ribbons, certificates, and \$50.00 U. S. Savings Bond, as well as other prizes from area merchants and businesses.
 - The top art entry in the elementary age/grade division will receive ribbons, certificates, as well as other prizes from area merchants and businesses.
 - All winning entries will be displayed at Spell-a-Bratton 2011, and at U. S. Bank locations 2010/2011 school year.
- * Posters will also be used to promote Community Education's Stand for Children Day, June 20. 2012. This year's theme is Good Neighbors.

The teacher or group leader (scouts, daycare, after school, etc.) submitting the most acceptable artwork will receive a gift basket containing a variety of coupons and gift certificates for locations in the Bowling Green area.
