



SPELL-A-BRATION U. S. Bank Art Show 2010

CALL TO PARTICIPANTS

Bowling Green/Warren County Community Education, U. S. Bank, and the Spell-A-Bration 2010 partners invite upper elementary, middle and high school youth to create an 18" X 12" reading/literacy poster for the annual Spell-a-Bration Art Show. Entries will be judged by independent judges. Top entries will receive savings bonds and prize baskets, as well as being displayed at Spell-a-Bration 2010, February 19, Sloan Convention Center. Winning posters will also be displayed at locations throughout the area, including bookstores, libraries, and schools, as well as US Bank locations for the remainder of the school year. They may possibly be reproduced and given to these locations for permanent display.

Primary students (K-2) are invited to participate in a reading/literacy themed art contest. They will be judged by the independent panel of judges and winning entries will receive ribbons and prize baskets from area merchants and businesses.

Rules & Regulations

All Poster entries:

- ◆ Posters must use one of the reading slogans and rubric provided.
 - ◆ Only original artwork is permitted. Clipart, photocopies, or tracings incorporated in the poster will not be accepted. Fragile media, i.e. pastel, charcoal, graphite, must be sealed with fixative. No glitter is allowed.
 - ◆ All posters must be vertical format, 18" X 12", unmounted and 2 dimensional. *(for Grades 3 – 12)*
 - ◆ Posters will be judged in these age categories: Grades 3 – 5, Grades 6 – 8, Grades 9 – 12.
 - ◆ All art entries must be vertical format, 9" X 12", and 2 dimensional. *(for Grades K – 2)*
 - ◆ Art contest entries will be judged as one category, grades K – 2.
 - ◆ Creased or folded posters will not be accepted.
 - ◆ All posters must be received by Friday, **January 15**. Posters should be brought to the Community Education office, 1227 Western Avenue, across from CDS #10.
 - ◆ Fill out the label and affix it to the back of the poster in the lower left corner.
 - ◆ Each division will be considered for the following:
 - The top poster entry in each age/grade division will receive ribbons, certificates, and \$50.00 U. S. Savings Bond, as well as other prizes from area merchants and businesses.
 - The top art entry in the elementary age/grade division will receive ribbons, certificates, as well as other prizes from area merchants and businesses.
 - All winning entries will be displayed at Spell-a-Bration 2010, and at U. S. Bank locations, Warren County Public library locations, and other businesses/schools, on a rotating schedule for (at least) the remainder of the 2009/2010 school year.
- * Winners will be asked to fill out and sign the Release Form before being awarded prizes. They must agree to terms before being allowed to go further with the process.
- * By submitting an entry, each contestant and his/her parent/legal guardian agree: they have read, understand, and comply with these official rules, that entries become the permanent property of Community Education and cannot be returned, that Community Education is not responsible for loss or damage to entry, that entries may be reproduced for advertising purposes without further consent, compensation or approval.

The teacher submitting the most acceptable artwork will receive a gift basket containing a variety of coupons and gift certificates for locations in the Bowling Green area.
