Would you love to teach the fun part of your subject area that you just can't get to during the academic year? Community Education is seeking certified teachers to serve as enrichment instructors for our two summer programs. Come teach it at one of them! Here are the details:

### Super Summer Club

Will be at BGISD's Bowling Green Learning Center (Old Morgantown Road)

Serves students who have completed kindergarten – 3<sup>rd</sup> grade by May 2019

Instructors teach four days per week, 1-4:35 p.m. (2:30-3:10 p.m. break) daily

Maximum of four, 40-minute classes per day  
Will teach the same topic each class period

Pay is \$19 per class, up to \$76 per day

### Camp Extreme

Will be at Bowling Green Learning Center (Old Morgantown Road)

Serves students who have completed 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grades by May 2019

Instructors teach four days per week, 12:10-3:25 p.m. (2-2:30 p.m. break) daily

Maximum of three, 50-minute classes per day  
Will teach the same topic each class period

Pay is \$20 per class, up to \$60 per day

Camp sessions are, May 28-June 6, June 10-20, June 24-July 5 (excluding July 4), July 8-18, July 22-26. Most of the sessions will be Monday-Thursday, however, there may be times, due to field trips, holidays, etc. you may work on a Friday instead. You will be given a calendar at the instructor orientation meeting in May. Instructors may apply to teach one or more sessions for either or both camps.

Classes generally are comprised of students from one grade level, but on occasion classes may contain two grade levels. (For example, kindergartners and first graders may be in a group together.)

Examples of past class topics include Silly Science, Space, Super Spanish, Around the World, Pottery, Music, CSI, Art, Drone Construction, Robotics, Headed Out West, Camp Out with Math, etc. However, we are always open to new ideas and class topics. We would like to focus some classes on STEM/STEAM education, with the possibility of robotics and sustainability. This year we will have access to a raised garden bed and would love to have classes geared towards plant development and gardening.

We have no homework, no assessments, and no evaluation of the students' work. Our classes are for enrichment and fun! Community Education also will provide the supplies you will need to teach your lessons.
